

## IMPLEMENTING PARTNERS FACT SHEET

### Disability Workstream



#### Project Brief

Humanity & Inclusion (HI), is working in partnership with the Royal Government of Cambodia, Organisation of Persons with Disabilities (OPDs), Physical Rehabilitation Centres (PRCs), and relevant health facilities to contribute to the implementation of the National Disability Strategic Plan (NDSP 2019-2023). The project aims to improve access to quality and inclusive services for all, including women and men with disabilities.

#### Project Outcomes

- Disability Action Council Secretary General (DAC-SG) effectively implements the National Technical Standards on Physical Accessibility-Infrastructure for Persons with Disabilities
- Kampong Cham province and the five PRCs managed by the Persons With Disabilities Foundation (PWDF) implement good practices and develop new tools aligned with the national standards and the needs of persons with disabilities

#### Key Interventions

- Support the implementation of the Technical Standards on Physical Accessibility-Infrastructure for Persons with Disabilities in target provinces
- Support the implementation of the accessibility in transportation for persons with disabilities
- Support the effective implementation of professional standards in 6 PRCs by supporting the Cambodian Physical Therapy Association (CPTA) and Khmer Association of Prosthetics and Orthotics (KhAPO)
- Provide training and coaching to PRC managers and PWDF staff in leadership, management, and governance roles to increase capacity to implement the Rehabilitation Management System (RMS) tool
- Support PWDF to elaborate a financial strategy and implementation plan, including cost-calculation, cost recovery, and financial management of PRCs.

#### COVID-19 Interventions

- Extend the remote rehabilitation service for the community to more PRCs

#### Beneficiaries

- Direct: PRC clients from Kampong Cham, PRC staff from 6 PRCs, PWDF, MoSVY, DAC, CPTA, and KhAPO
- Indirect: Women and men with disabilities in targeted provinces.

#### Geographic Location

PRCs: Kampong Cham and Tbong Khmum provinces and the PRCs in Siem Reap, Takeo, Kratie, Prey Veng, Khien Khleang (Phnom Penh) and national level support  
Dissemination of the national technical standards on physical accessibility in 10 provinces
