### Disability Workstream



#### Project Brief

Humanity & Inclusion (HI), operating name of Handicap International, is working in partnership with government, Disabled People's Organisations (DPOs), physical rehabilitation centres (PRCs), and health facilities to contribute to the implementation of the National Disability Strategic Plan (NDSP 2019-2023). The project aims to improve access to quality and inclusive services for all, including women and men with disabilities.

#### Project Outcomes

- Support Disability Action Council (DAC) to implement the National Accessibility Guidelines efficiently.
- Support Persons With Disabilities Foundation (PWDF) to manage the selected PRCs more effectively.
- Support sub-national authorities to promote inclusive Commune Investment Program (CIP), and DPO to better engage in this CIP process.

#### Key Interventions

- Develop a practical training toolkit and provide training on the national accessibility standard
- Conduct audit on accessibility of transportation.
- Support implementation of a minimum package of services for PRCs, including the introduction of Rehabilitation Management System (RMS) and cost calculations.
- Training and coaching of PRC managers and PWDF staff on leadership, management and governance, and on GBV.
- Support engagement of DPOs into Commune Investment planning process.

#### COVID-19 Interventions

- Participate in the COVID-19 Task force to design easy-to-read posters and communication materials and distribute it to our beneficiaries in intervention areas.
- Mobilize staff to inform people with disabilities on preventive measures and COVID-19 symptoms and clarify referral pathways.
- Develop Accessible Health Care Facilities Factsheet and disseminate it online to hospitals and health centre directors.
- Set up a remote rehabilitation system at Kampong Cham PRC.

#### Beneficiaries

- Direct: PRC clients, PWDF, MoSVY, DAC, Commune councilors and Representative Self-Help Disabilities Organisation Batheay (RSDOB).
- Indirect: Women and men with disabilities and their families.
